Camper Code of Conduct 2021

This code is in effect beginning June 2nd, 2021.

Campers,

McGowan Lake Campground welcomes you back! Please read this Code of Conduct (the Code) and review it with all family members. The rules in this Code must be followed to ensure we all stay safe and do not engage in activities that contravene any Provincial or Federal Government regulations and ensure we comply with all health regulations. It is important to remember that, ultimately, we are all in charge of our own health and safety. Please remember to bring a mask and hand sanitizer for the occasion that you will need it.

This Code is over and above our normal campground rules, which still apply. Strict enforcement of all rules will be in place for all registered names on your occupancy agreement. Any camper, regardless of age who breaches this Code will be asked to leave the campground immediately until social distancing measures are lifted.

If you have a fever or flu-like symptoms, please stay home. If you have tested positive for COVID-19, are a presumptive case, or have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive or is a presumptive case, we request that you do not attempt to enter the campground. Please remain at your residence until you have been cleared by your local health department and/or you have finished your self-isolation of 14 days.

If you are returning from travel from outside of the Province of Ontario, do not plan to visit the campground for a period of 14 days, please remain home.

The following rules are in regards to each step of the Ontario Re-Opening Plan and are subject to change:

Visitors

Each campsite will be allotted two spaces at the end of this document (Note 1) to register visitors (i.e. – a couple, a family or a friend). The registered visitors must be in your social bubble and will be the only visitors allowed from June 2nd, 2021 to October 1st, 2021. Visitors must check in at the office each time they arrive at the park. Please refer to the chart below for when visitors are permitted.

Before Step 1	No visitors allowed in the campground
Step 1	Visitors registered with the office are allowed for the day
Step 2	Visitors registered with the office are allowed for overnight
Step 3	Visitors registered with the office are allowed for overnight

Common Areas

Before Step 1: All common areas and recreational facilities will be closed with the exception of the boat docks/boat launch. Only one person/family will be allowed on the boat docks or at the boat launch at a time.

Steps 1 – 3: The following common areas will remain closed until further notice. All areas that are closed are indicated with a sign. If you are unsure whether something is closed or not, please contact the office for clarification.

- Playgrounds, volleyball court, kid's room, rec hall

Limit of campers in an area

Campers are expected to respect and obey all signage which restricts the number of people permitted in certain areas. Social distancing and gathering rules must be followed.

Limit of People on a Campsite

Before Step 1: Campers may SOCIAL GATHER together to a maximum of 5 people outdoors while adhering to social distancing guidelines.

Step 1 – 3: Campers who ARE NOT in a social bubble may SOCIAL GATHER together to a maximum of 10 people per campsite with a maximum of 6 adults in order to adhere to social distancing guidelines. (Please refer to Note 2 at the end of the document on Social Bubbles vs. Social Gathering) All Campers must be on their own sites by 12:00 a.m.

Children under the age of 16

We expect that all parents will ensure their children will obey the rules at all times. If your children cannot follow these rules, please do not bring them to the campground at this time.

Driving/Walking

Driving is permitted to your site upon arrival and when leaving the park. Please limit other driving to ONLY what is NECESSARY.

At all times campers must obey social distancing rules and gathering laws as mandated by the Province of Ontario. You must stay 2 meters or 6 feet away from other campers. You may use walking trails if social distancing rules are followed. If you walk by someone on the road, a mask MUST be worn as there is not enough room to socially distance.

Events/Activities

All special events/activities have been postponed until further notice for the 2021 season.

Office/Store

Store hours are posted. Please do not approach the store if you see another customer already outside. Please line up at the designated entrance and obey all social distancing rules. A mask MUST be worn when approaching the store.

Garbage

Two designated garbage and recycling stations have been set up at the store and the bay washroom. Please follow the rules for garbage and separating recycles.

On-Site Residences

Our homes are strictly prohibited. At no time should anyone approach our residences. If you need assistance, you may call the campground at 613-268-2234.

Respect of others and staff

All Customers, guests and staff are responsible for respecting the dignity and rights of everyone at the campground. Every person has a right to expect their time at the campground will be without any type of discrimination or harassment. We will not tolerate, ignore, or condone discrimination or harassment and we are committed to promoting respectful conduct, tolerance and diversity at all times.


