Dog Park Policies – Schedule F

Rules and regulations, hours of operation and emergency contact numbers are posted at the entrance gate to the dog park.

- Use the off-leash area at your own risk
- Owners must clean up after their dog(s)
- Keep your dog within your sight and under verbal control
- Dogs must be on-leash until inside the gated area
- Dogs that are in heat, sick or aggressive are not permitted
- No more than two dogs per person in the off-leash area
- Supervise children under 16 inside the off-leash area
- No food (for dogs or humans) is allowed inside the dog park
- Choke, spikes, chains or pinch collars are not allowed
- Up-to-date rabies vaccination and municipal dog tags are required
- Avoid bringing aggressive dogs into the park.
- Dogs required by law to be leashed and muzzled must remain so
- Please prevent your dog from damaging property and digging holes
- Smoking is not permitted in the park.
- Professional dog trainers are not permitted to conduct business in off-leash areas

Off-leash area users are subject to the Ontario Dog Owners' Liability Act and the Tay Valley Township By-laws.

Owners will be held liable for all actions of their dogs.

Failure to follow the rules will result in your dog(s) being banned from use of the dog park.
